



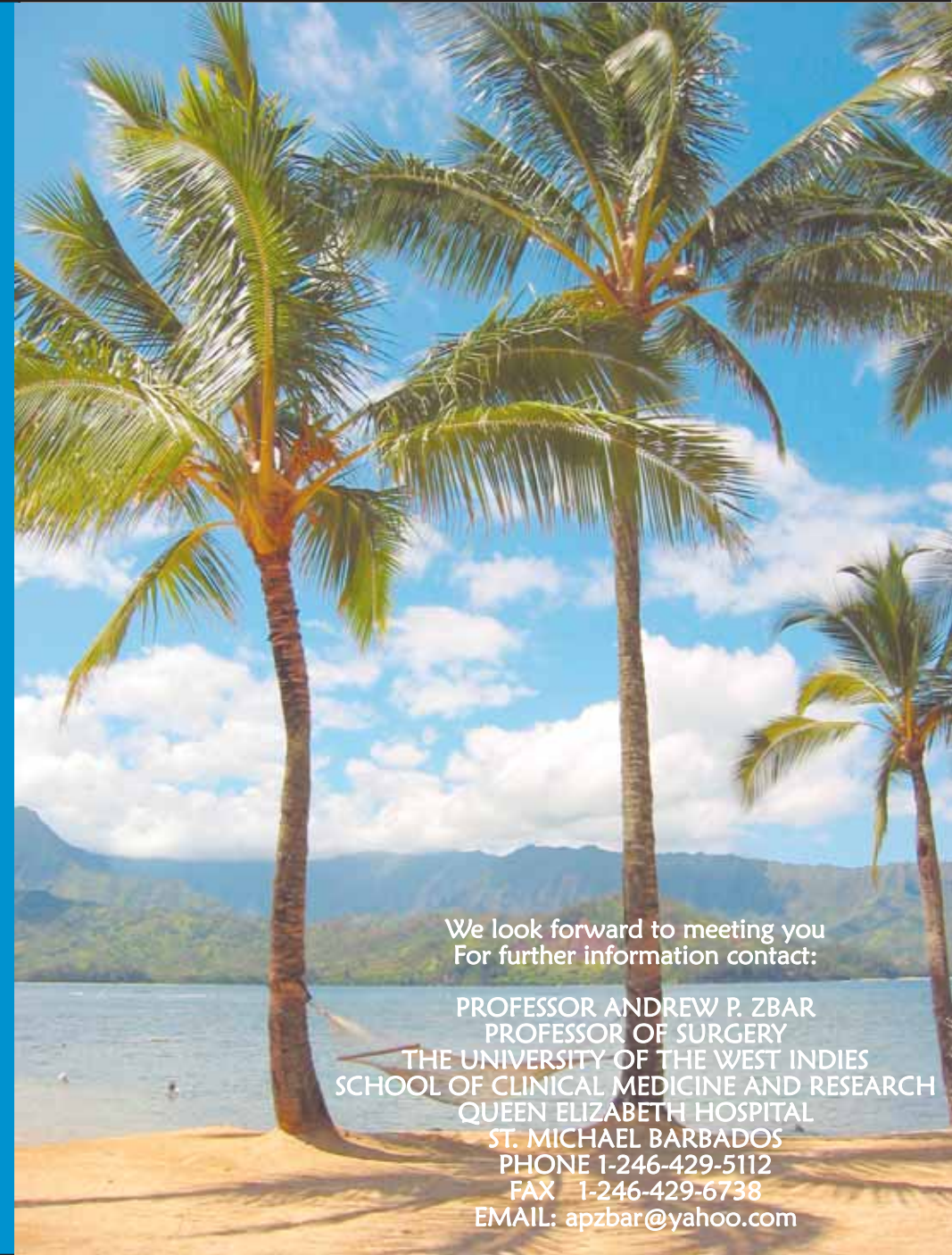
INTERNATIONAL COLORECTAL CANCER CONFERENCE BARBADOS, JANUARY 18th -21st 2008
